

**P6 M MILK FEED PLUS PROJECT  
Rises in Sta. Maria Bulacan**



A P6 million PL 480 project is on its final stages of completion in Pulong Buhangin, Caypombo, Sta. Maria, Bulacan.

The project is being managed by the National Agricultural and Fishery Council (NAFC) , and implemented by the National Dairy Authority, (NDA).

The construction of the New Sta. Maria Dairy Milk Processing Plant is to support the local Dairy Cooperative after the old processing plant, located in Bagbaguin, Sta. Maria, Bulacan was severely damaged by Typhoon Ondoy.



The project started in June 2011 and is expected to be completed by December this year.

The new plant assures a faster and more efficient processing of the milk collected and delivered to the plant by individual dairy farmers and other primary cooperatives.

The new location will also trigger economic activity in the vicinity as well as promote local consumption of dairy products in the community.
