

BADACO SELLS FRESH MILK, TOO!



Batangas Dairy Cooperative (BADACO) is now selling its own pasteurized fresh milk in Barangay Inosluban, Lipa City where its dairy animals are raised. One liter of ESL (Extended Shelf Life) pasteurized fresh milk costs PH 60.00 which can last up to 10 days inside the refrigerator.

Since the start of its farm operation in November 24, 2009, all milk produce of BADACO were brought to and purchased by its sister company, the Batangas Agribusiness Center (BAC) which supplies Starbucks, a leading coffee chain in Metro Manila. Having seen better opportunities with the growing demand for more fresh liquid milk, the coop is set to increase its animal holdings by seeking additional animals through the DMF program of the NDA.

Prospective and interested farmers can also undergo a hands-on farm training course for a fee. The farm boasts of some 400 dairy animals managed by a highly experienced farm manager and skilled farm workers.
