Forty five (45) dairy farmers in Sariaya, Quezon completed an On-site Farm Improvement Practices Seminar conducted by the National Dairy Authority last July 1-2, 2010.

Participants are members of the Palcon Dairy Multi Purpose Cooperative, one of the most progressive dairy communities assisted by NDA. Records show that as of May this year, this coop boasts of a total herd inventory of 832 with 149 animals on the milk line producing an average of 1,112 liters per day valued at about P24,464 per day at an average farm gate price of P22.00 per liter. Palcon Dairy MPC is a member of the Katipunan ng Kooperatibang Maggagatas Ink. a federation of dairy farmers in South Luzon.
