

DA-NDA Milk Feeding launched in Sagad Elementary School in Pasig City

Some 680 metric tons of no-fat dry milk donation coming from the US was processed into UHT chocomilk and biscuits under the brand name Gatas Pinoy and Biskwit Pinoy respectively, under the Food for Progress Act of the United States Department of Agriculture. The formal launching was done in Sagad Elementary School in Pasig City. This will benefit some 81,718 Grade I pupils in 265 public elementary schools in Regions 1, III, IV-A and NCR.

The move is seen to address the malnutrition concern for (children affected by typhoons... Ondoy and Pepeng . Gatas Pinoy in tetra cartons and Biskwit Pinoy will be given to milk feeding beneficiaries for 60 feeding school days starting Nov 15 to February 2011.
