

## Update on Performance of Philippine Dairy Production

January – September 2010

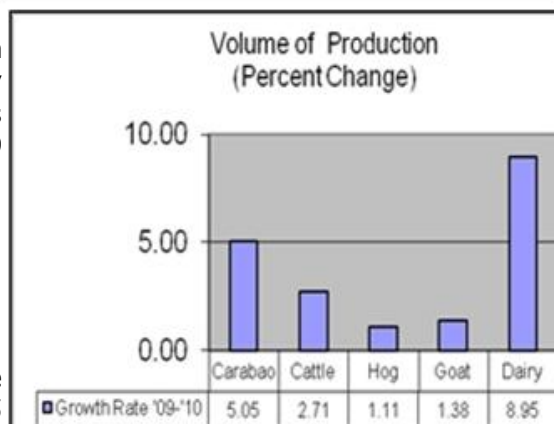
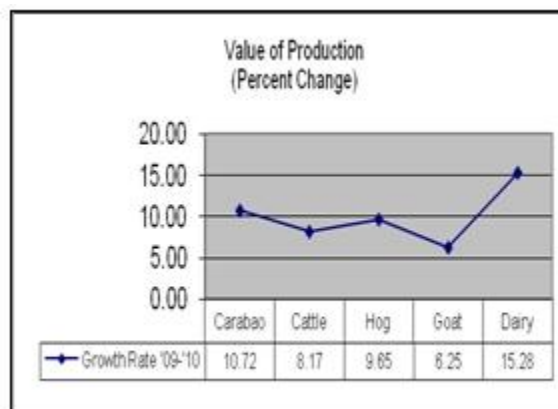
### Highlights:

Based on the latest report of the Bureau of Agricultural Statistics (BAS), the livestock subsector managed to grow by 1.07 percent this year. It accounted for 12.74 percent of total agricultural production. Generally, there were gains in both production and prices. Bigger gains were noted in the production of dairy at 14.59 percent and carabao at 3.60 percent. The livestock subsector also registered a relatively high growth rate of 9.44 percent in gross earnings of P152.10 billion at current prices.

Of the livestock sector, only dairy came up with double-digit up trend. The substantial increases in the number of animals on the milk line, specifically for cattle were recorded in the last two (2) quarters of the year. Dairy production went up by 14.59 percent this year.

Total dairy production reached to 11.94 thousand MT from last year's record of 10.42 thousand MT.

Dairy grossed 15.28 percent more this year. On the average, farmgate price of dairy reached to P30.05 per liter.



Please note: The NDA-assisted dairy projects maintained their significant share: more than 2/3 of the total national milk output or equivalent to 8.53 thousand MT.
