

BAGUIO DAIRY FARM GETS A MAKEOVER



After more than 45 years of operation, Baguio Dairy Farm finally gets another makeover, with NDA infusing a million pesos to rehabilitate the equipment of the milking parlor and processing plant in time for the arrival of additional 25 dairy animals from the 13th batch of the imported dairy animals.

With Engr. Ian Pamaos, PDO IV Alex Recidoro and Breeding Specialist Ronnie A. Ernie comprising the NDA Team, infra structures for the milking parlor and the processing plant is currently underway. Construction of improved facilities is aimed at boosting milk production and minimizing spillage and losses in the process.

The farm is being operated by Mountain High Dairy Cooperative. Presently the coop has 40 dairy animals and 10 on the milk line with an average production of 2,900 liters per month as of June, 2012.
